- 01** A clearinghouse for medical billing connects providers and payers
- 02** Claims are checked for errors and cleaned up before being transmitted electronically
- 03** Clearinghouses can help accelerate the billing process by removing errors, evaluating information, and setting up EFT
- 04** Clearinghouses examine claims for inaccuracies and verify their accuracy
- 05** Clearinghouses facilitate communication between insurance companies and healthcare providers
- 06** Non-standard data is converted into a standard format that payer billing systems can use
- 07** Clearinghouses enable timely payments and a more efficient revenue cycle

Clearinghouse Medical Billing: HOW

01 Healthcare practitioners install medical billing software on their PCs

02 The software allows them to transmit claims electronically to the clearinghouse

03 The clearinghouse reviews claims for improper coding and invoicing



04 After the review, the clearinghouse forwards claims to the appropriate insurance companies

05 The entire billing process is completed electronically

06 The process adheres to healthcare system norms for security
